

Review of Country/Region Classification and Updated Border Measures for Inbound Travellers



From 26 October, 2359 hours:



Updated border measures for travellers from countries/regions in Category II, III and IV.



All passengers with a 14-day travel history to Bangladesh, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka prior to departure to Singapore will be allowed to enter and transit through Singapore, subject to Category IV border measures.

[^] 14-day travel history does not include the time spent in countries/regions whereby traveller transits enroute to Singapore. It does include the time spent in Singapore by traveller before embarking on the overseas travel (if any). This does not apply to travellers under the Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL). * Countries/Regions may have vaccination-differentiated border measures. Please check <https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg> for details.

Travellers who are not Singapore Citizens (SCs), Permanent Residents (PRs) or Long-Term Pass Holders (LTPHs), may enter Singapore for short-term visits only if they are arriving from **Category I countries/regions**, unless if arrangements are separately announced (e.g. Vaccinated Travel Lanes). LTPHs with passes issued by the Ministry of Manpower may have to comply with additional requirements.

[#] Travellers with vulnerable household members are reminded to isolate in the room and minimise contact with the vulnerable household members.

[@] The charges for 10-day SHN at dedicated SHN facility is \$1,450.
